

Center for the Arts Alcoholic Beverage Policy for Renters

1. The Center for the Arts (the Center) is subject to all rules and regulations of the State of Colorado and the Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division.
2. The Front of House manager will help enforce Colorado liquor laws during events where alcohol is served.
3. The bar will close after intermission or no later than one-half hour prior to the end of the show or event.
4. All bartenders will be properly trained by the Bar Manager. The Bartender's Training Manual is part of this Policy.
5. No alcohol, other than that provided by the Center, may be served or consumed at Center functions. Additionally, no alcohol may be removed from the Center building.
6. No alcohol may be brought into the backstage or side-stage areas unless purchased by the Center for the Arts for the Renter. If backstage alcohol is required, it can be ordered by the Renter through the Bar Manager.
7. Hosted events, where alcohol is purchased by the Renter and served complimentary, require the use of a trained Center staff bartender for serving. This alcohol may not be brought in from an outside source. It must be purchased through the Center for the Arts bar at the regular per glass prices.
8. The consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages by persons under 21 is prohibited, even if provided by a parent or relative. All drinks must be served to the individual consuming them. Serving multiple drinks per person is prohibited.
9. Acceptable proof of age may be required of any patron. If an acceptable proof of age is not available from the questionable patron, no service will be provided and the questionable ID will be confiscated.
10. Bartenders and/or Center management will deny alcoholic beverage service to anyone at anytime if it appears that underage drinking or guest intoxication is occurring. The staff has the sole right to make decisions regarding appropriate service of alcoholic beverages without client and/or patron recourse.
11. At its sole discretion, Center management may require sufficient security personnel be present to maintain order, to prevent situations that might lead to bodily harm or physical damage, or to take care of individuals who have lost control.
12. The use of carpooling and/or designated drivers is encouraged for all events.
13. The Center for the Arts bar will not make product orders or changes to its products based on Renter's sponsors or paid advertisers.
