### **Center for the Arts Crested Butte Announces Partnership with the Crested Butte Film Festival**

The Center for the Arts is proud to announce a new partnership with the Crested Butte Film Festival. "Over the last few years, the Center has been building incredible partnerships with like organizations such as the CB Dance Collective and the Art Studio. The film is about two South Africans who set out to discover what happened to their unlikely musical hero, the mysterious 1970s rock 'n' roller, Rodriguez.

The partnership will also include new technical equipment at the Center, resulting in a state-of-the-art facility for film presentation, something that both organizations are very excited about. According to Festival Co-Director Michael Brody, "through high-definition filmmaking, the art of film has grown substantially, and now we will have equipment that can match the technical innovations of our filmmakers."

The Center For the Arts will also be home to, and one of the primary venues of, the Crested Butte Film Festival, an annual four-day festival of international film that takes place the *last weekend of September*, September 26 - 29, 2013.
